

Privacy notice regarding the processing of personal data

1. The controller of personal data is Andea Solutions Sp. z o. o. with its main office in Kraków, Poland, address: 26 Kapelanka Street, 30-347 Kraków, entered into the register of entrepreneurs kept by the District Court for Kraków-Śródmieście in Kraków, 11th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under number 0000419451 (hereinafter referred to as the "Controller" or the "Company").
2. The Controller can be contacted via e-mail: info@andea.com or in writing, by sending a letter to the above-mentioned HQ address.
3. Personal data is processed for the promotion and marketing of the Company's products and services, as well as for building and promoting a positive image of the Company.
4. The scope of the processed data - name, surname, image, voice, company, position held and data resulting from combining these data.
5. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is your consent.
6. Personal data will be transferred to:
 - a) entities related to the Company (that controls the Company, are controlled directly or indirectly by the Company or controlled by the same entity as the Company), to the extent that it is necessary for internal administrative purposes of such a specific group of entities,
 - b) entities processing data at the request of the Company in the scope of services provided by these entities to the Company, always on the basis of an agreement concluded with the Company (or terms and conditions of such entities accepted by Andea) and in accordance with the instructions received by the Company,
 - c) entities that provide services in the field of informing about events related to the Company, online media, social media platforms and video hosting, sharing, and services platform providers.
7. The above-mentioned recipients of data are based mainly in Poland and other countries of the European Economic Area (EEA). In the case of recipients outside the EEA, we will make sure that they provide a high level of personal data protection safeguards, including the use of standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission, and if required - provide additional security measures.
8. You have the right to:
 - a) request access to personal data, rectification, deletion or limitation of processing,
 - b) lodge a complaint with the supervisory body - the President of the Personal Data Protection Office,
 - c) request the transfer of personal data, including sending data to another data controller,
 - d) withdraw consent at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing prior to its withdrawal.
9. Providing personal data is voluntary.
